**Term:** Judgment

**Quote:** A *proposition* [...] is not to be understood as the lingual expression of a judgment. It is, on the contrary, that sign of which the judgment is one replica and the lingual expression another. But a judgment is distinctly *more* than the mere mental replica of a proposition. It not merely expresses the proposition, but it goes further and *accepts* it.
