**Term:** Sign

**Quote:** A Sign is anything which represents something else (so far as it is complete), and if it represents itself it is as a part of another sign which represents something other than itself, and it represents itself in other *circumstances*, in other connections. [—]

Either a Sign is to be defined as something which *truly* represents something else or else as something which *professes* to represent something.
